Minutes from April 22, 2021 were approved. Matthew Grant motioned to approve. David Nelson seconded. Motion passed: 15 voted to approve - 0 opposed - 2 abstained

Curriculum Change and Revised Catalog Copy – Georgia WebMBA Program: The reasons for this change are: a) The change makes the course more marketable, current, and more accurately captures the essence of the content taught in the course; b) it expands content on business intelligence tools i.e. Business Intelligence (BI) Tools for Data Analysis.

Linda Most motioned to approve. Kelly Heckaman seconded. Motion passed: 15 voted to approve 0 opposed 0 abstained.

- 1) Advising Tool Kit Crystal Marshall shared tips and some best practices in advising graduate students that was presented in a summer workshop. Several GEC members indicated they would like to attend a similar workshop this Fall.
- 2) Graduate Admissions Updates Rebecca Petrella updated on moving into a new CRM (Slate) since Radius is at end-of-life. Slate is used by most USG institutions and will be a joint effort with Undergraduate Admissions. Also opened discussion on the need to address contingencies in Acceptance Letters. Seeking input from programs regarding how to improve as electronic letter communications are built into Slate.
- 3) Search for Administrative Coordinator replacement Dr. da Cruz updated. The search committee (Drs. Colette Drouillard, Taralyn Hartsel, and Keith Lee) are meeting next week to review the applications and discuss inviting candidates to campus for interviews. Currently, there are 15 applications. Question on minimum qualifications was raised. Minimum education requirement is an \* Degree. In the meantime, programs should continue sending documents, questions, etc. to Dr. da Cruz.
- 4) Graduate Assistantships Dr. da Cruz updated. GA as Instructors of record are included in training along with Part-time Faculty in order to provide them support and resources as required by SACS-COC. GAs who are Instructors of Record will also be added to a BlazeView Course for workshops and collaboration throughout the year for additional support and resources. Also, the 2022-2023/2024 Competitive GA Allocation Applications will open in early September. The Committee will begin reviewing applications in October.
- 5) Dissertation Dive Ins Dr. da Cruz updated. Seeking at least one more faculty member to mentor doctoral students in finishing their dissertations. There is a \$500/semester stipend for working with 7-10 doctoral students. The meetings take place virtually.
- 6) General Program Email Alias Dr. da Cruz updated. Some programs already have a program email alia the request from IT. Discussion included the need to have more than one person to have access to student questions in case the program coordinator is not available to respond.
- 7) AGS/SGA Updates Emily Brown updated. Emily introduced herself and the new acting president and discussed upcoming events.
- 8) Items from the Floor?
  - a) Dr. Nelson requested that we invite Dr. Chu, Director of Housing to our next meeting to talk about on-campus housing options for graduate students.
