

Confidential Financial Statement
[for students in the Intensive English Program only]

U.S. Immigration Law requires you to certify that you have sufficient funds available for your academic and living expenses. Costs vary greatly depending on living arrangements and spending habits, but \$10,000 is the estimated minimum cost for a program of four months. \$29,672.00 is the estimated minimum funds needed for an **10-month academic year based on 2023-2024 school-year expenses (see below) :**

Family Expenses If you are married and plan to bring your spouse and/or children, you must also certify at least \$5,000 for your spouse or first dependent and \$2,000 per year for each additional child. In addition, health insurance for international students is required and is strongly recommended for dependents.

*Students must show funding for a minimum of two sessions. If you intend to come for only two sessions, the minimum required funding is **\$10,000.00**
