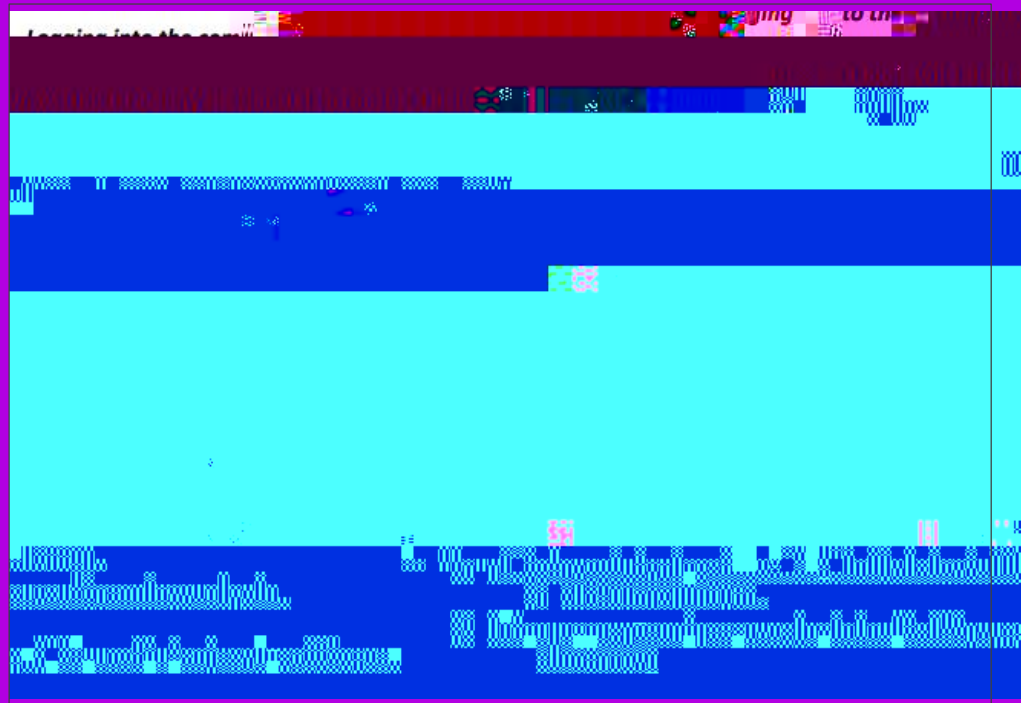

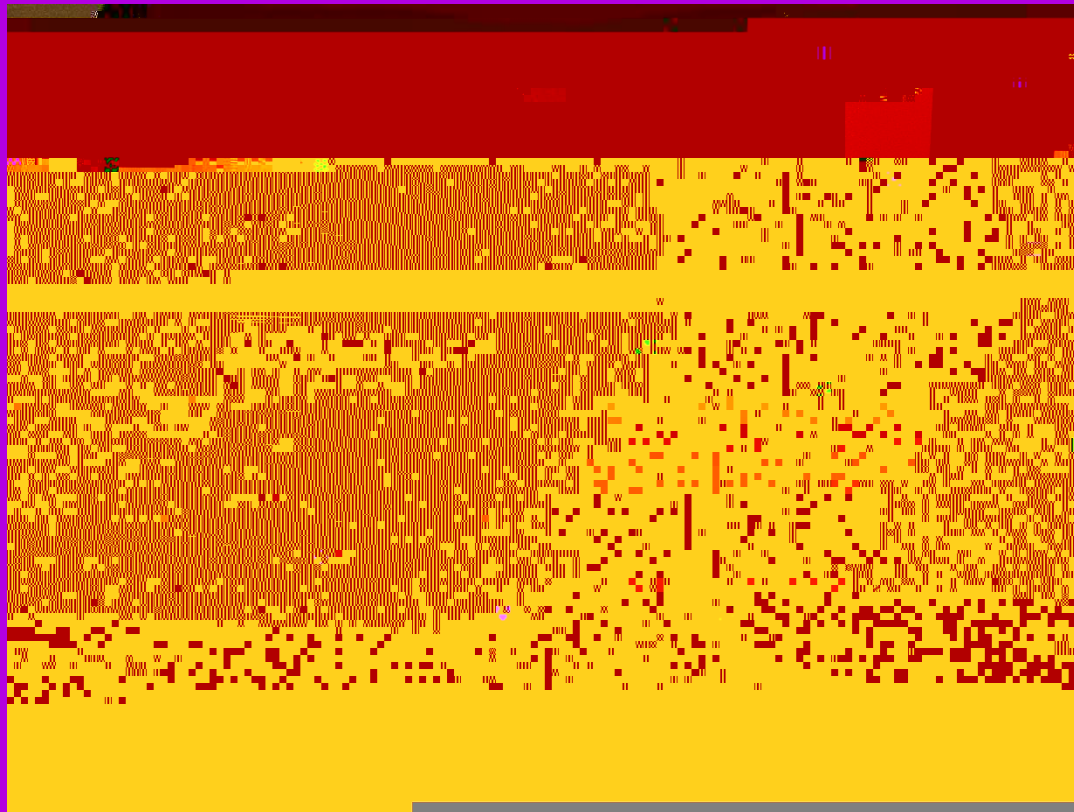
Control Touchpanel

The Crestron Touch Panel controls classroom technology.

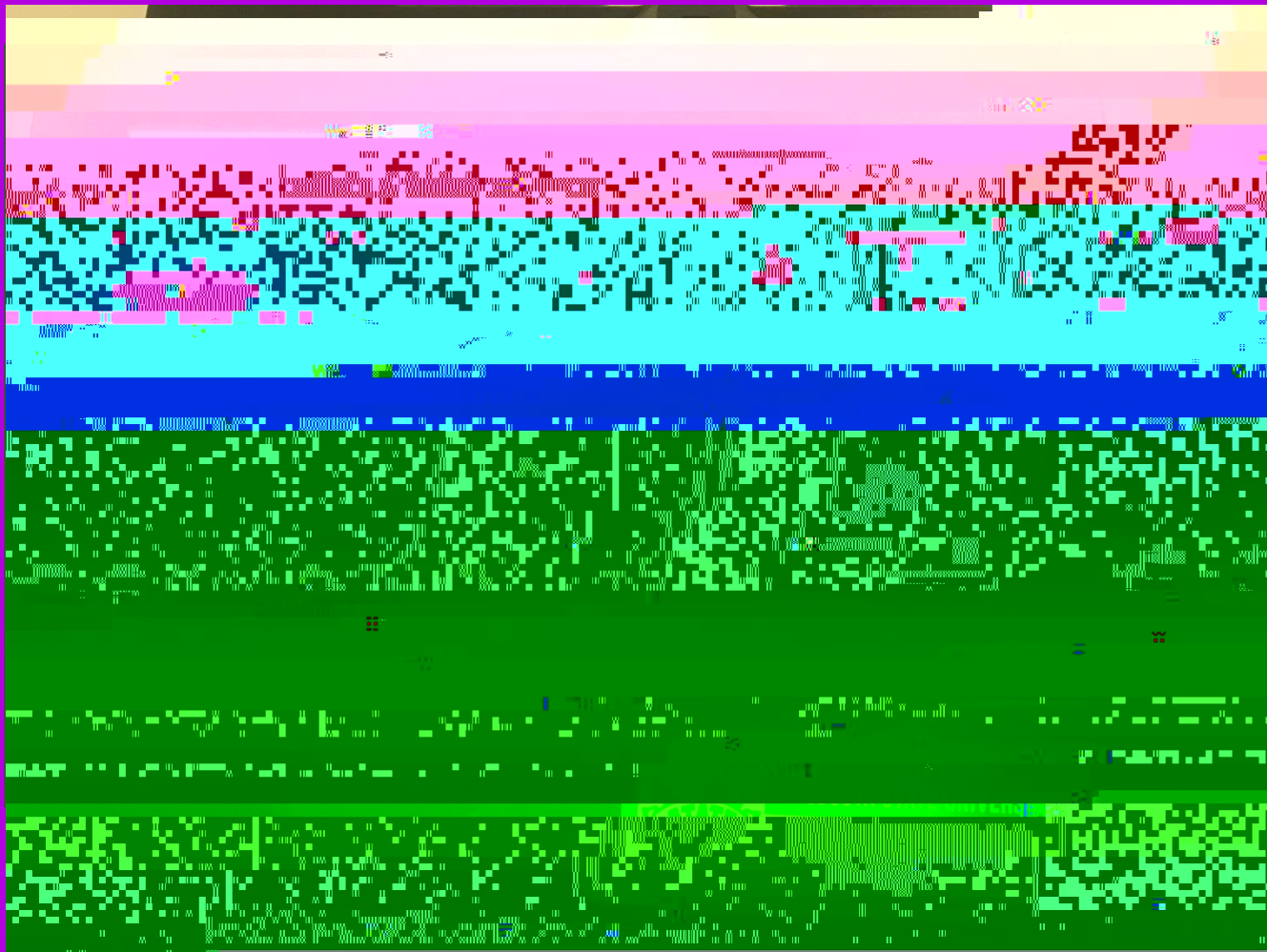

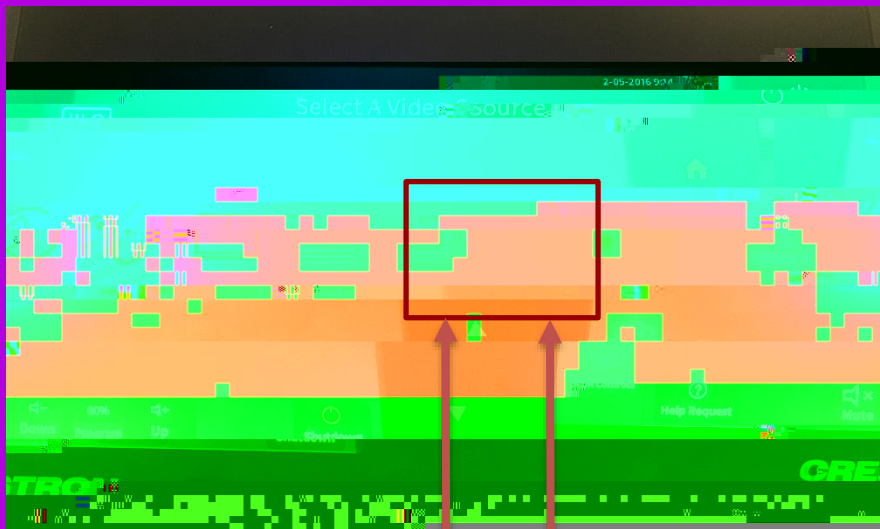

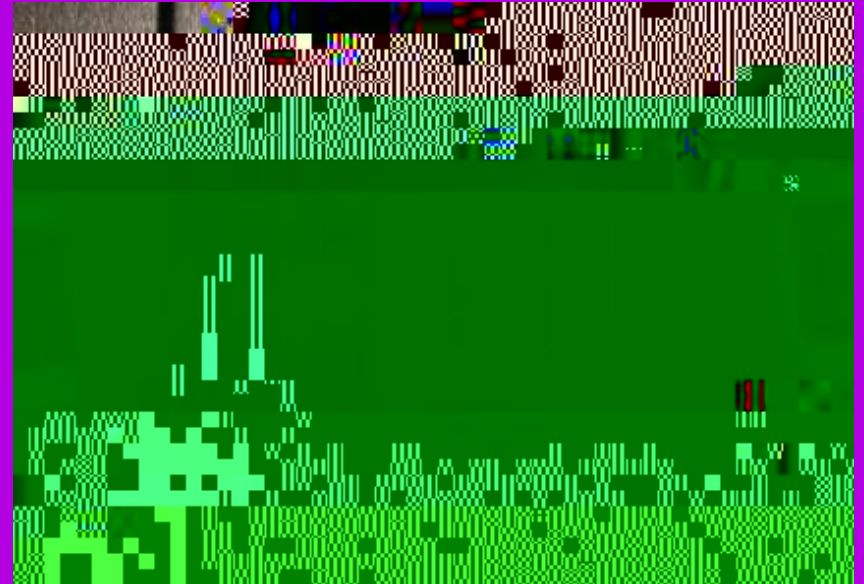

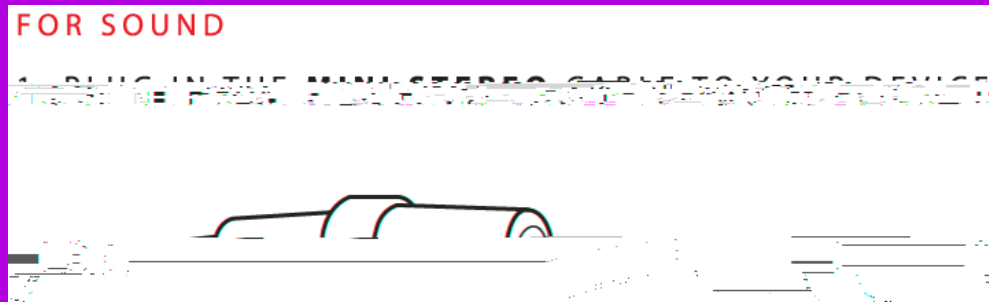
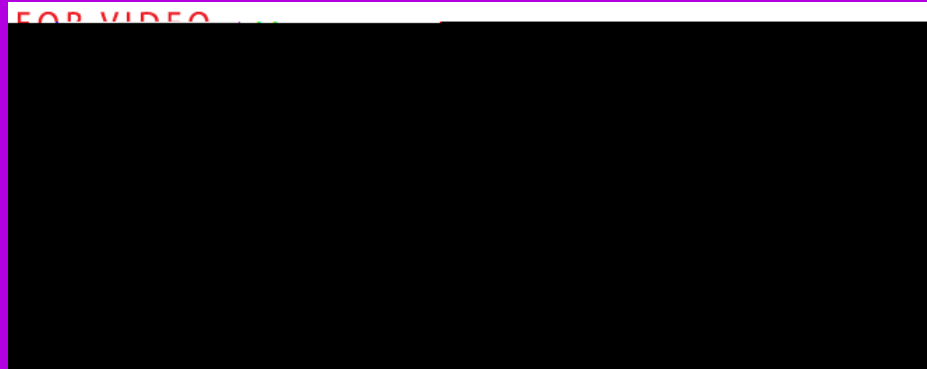


HDMI Cable

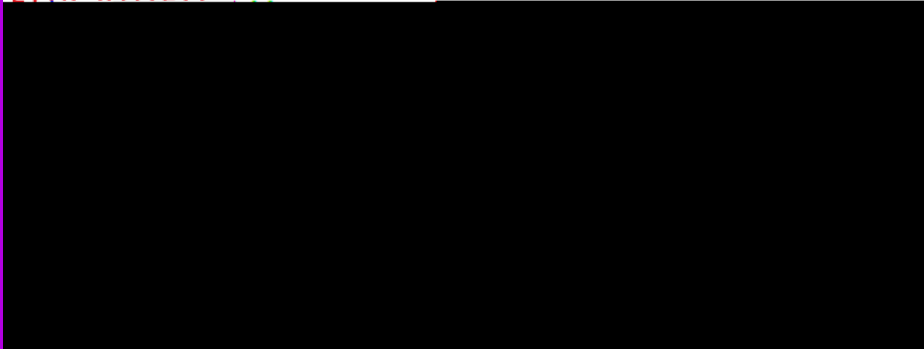

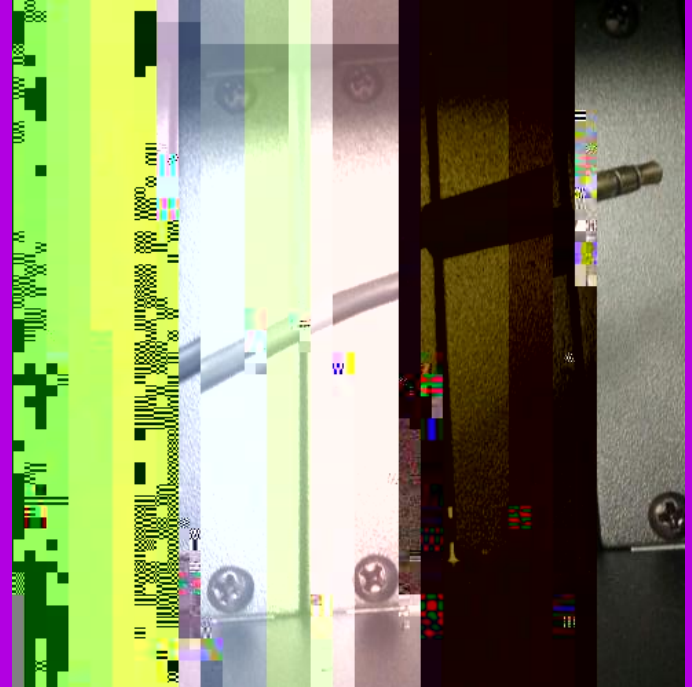

Mini Stereo Cable

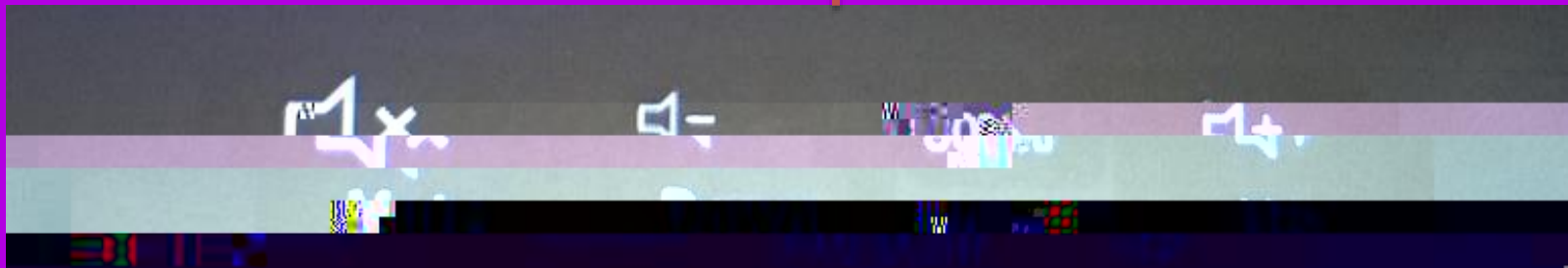
FOR SOUND

Volume Controls are located at the bottom of the screen

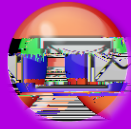
