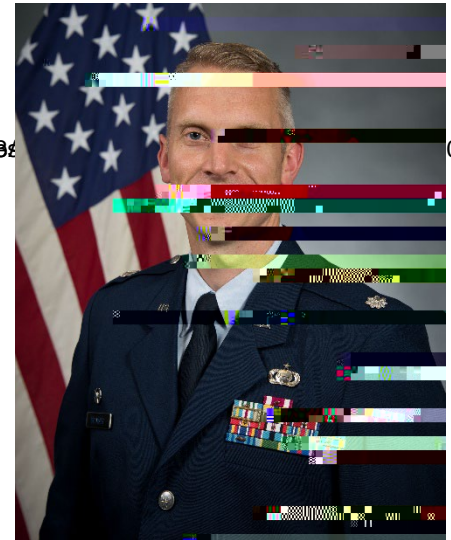




LIEUTENANT COLONEL LUCAS M. BROMMER
