

The Department of Curriculum, Leadership, and Technology offers programs which lead to clear-renewable certification in performance-based leadership (PL). Specialist and certification students may enter in any semester and complete their programs in three (3) semesters. Courses are delivered in a variety of formats including online, weekend, and condensed summer sessions.

All performance-based leadership candidates must submit an assurance form from a local school system verifying candidates serve in leadership roles as defined by their local systems and supporting the performance-

Prior to enrolling in required course work, a candidate must meet the Georgia PSC pre-service requirement for performance-based leadership preparation by holding a clear/renewable Leadership (L) certificate at the master's level or higher, or holding a master's degree in Educational Leadership, or completing LEAD 7420 (Ethical and Legal Issues for Leadership) and LEAD 7020, (Developing Leadership Capacity in Schools and Communities). Topics addressed in these courses include school law and ethics, organizational leadership, teaching and learning, and using data for school improvement. The approximate cost associated with the two online pre-service courses is \$1900 based on fall, 2011 tuition and fees. Prior graduate level course work will be evaluated to determine appropriate substitutions. These requirements are embedded into the doctoral concentration.
